Alit Glass Structures Ltd are a design and build specialist contractor providing bespoke glass structures to the commercial and domestic markets and is committed to the concept of reducing to a minimum any actions that have an adverse effect on the environment. This commitment extends not only to its own actions but also to any subcontractors employed. It supports this commitment by operating a quality management system.

In conducting its business it aims to prevent pollution and to save natural resources by operating in the most environmentally efficient and friendly way and by recycling wherever this is practical. This it does by not only keeping its use of materials down to a minimum but also its use of non-renewable resources. Furthermore it aims in its design and construction techniques to enable its clients to occupy buildings that minimise the use of energy.

This commitment extends to all areas of its business whether carried out on its own or on its clients premises. It further aims to continuously improve its environmental performance in order to safeguard the quality of the environment, both locally and globally. To facilitate its commitment it operates as follows: -

Waste disposal

Wherever possible recyclable waste is returned to approved companies for recycling.

Top soil, sub-soil and hardcore

These are separated when removed and are carefully re-used in the correct location wherever possible.

Wildlife

Working as it does in the open countryside the company endeavours to reduce disruption to flora and fauna to the minimum, putting back disturbed ground to the original state as far as is practical. It will always work within the environmental law and specified guidelines and will aim always to better the minimum legal requirements.

Paper

Computer paper is purchased only from suppliers who can demonstrate that the paper comes from managed resources. Wherever possible recycled paper is purchased. Used paper is re-used wherever possible and when scrapped is sent for recycling.

Toner cartridges

These are sent to specialist companies for refilling and re-cycled toner cartridges are purchased whenever possible.

Electricity

Care is taken when purchasing computers, fax. machines, workshop equipment and other electrical appliances purchased that they are manufactured for low energy consumption.

**Transport**

Company vehicles and construction plant are well maintained in order to minimise fuel use and keep harmful hydrocarbon emissions to a minimum. Wherever possible vehicle sharing is undertaken and public transport is used when appropriate.

Legislation and regulations

All applicable legislation and regulations are adhered to at all times and it is Alit Glass Structures Ltd policy to keep up to date and implement the requirements of all new environmental legislation.

Management responsibilities

The Director and senior management are responsible, both individually and collectively for communicating to all employees the environmental needs of the company and for enacting the environmental policy of the company.

Local requirements

It is the aim of Alit Glass Structures Ltd, irrespective of any regulations or legislation to be a good neighbour and, while providing its services to reduce to an absolute minimum any environmental aspects.

Review of environmental policy, objectives and targets

The company are to set a number of environmental objectives that will be publicised to staff, clients and the public. These targets will be set and regularly reviewed by means of its non-conformance control and management review processes.
